**Dear Federation,**

On May 26th and 27th the European Championships will be held in Italy.

The J.J.E.U. Referee Committee, with consultation of Mr. H. Sandberg (the director of the J.J.I.F. Referee Committee), have selected the referees as mentioned in the attachment.

**It is only allowed to send referees mentioned on the list** and with a maximum of three. Countries which have more than three names on the list must choose the three referees they want to send.

Furthermore, we remind you that Continental Referees must also have experience as a referee outside your own country.

In addition, positive reports from the J.J.E.U. Referee Committee are obligatory for referees to continue their education for their next referee license.

We assume all referees aspire to reach the status of World A Referee and we hope to see them often at big International tournaments so they can acquire their needed experience.

In case your referees do not meet the requirements, they will not be chosen for, e.g., the European Championships.
